Re: Keene Creditors Trust Statute of Limitations Deadline

Dear Claimants' Counsel:

The purpose of this letter is to remind Claimant's Counsel that asbestos personal injury claimants:

- i) who filed against, but were not paid, by Keene prior to the Petition Date or,
- ii) who qualified for the tolling of statute of limitations period for injuries that occurred prior to or during the bankruptcy period,

the asbestos personal injury claims must be filed and received by the Trust no later than April 15, 2009.

In addition, any claim diagnosed after the Petition Date must be filed with the Trust within three (3) years after the date of diagnosis or by April 15, 2009, whichever occurs later, unless the claim falls into a disease category suspended by the Trust. The statute of limitations shall continue to be deemed tolled for Disease Categories in which the Trust has suspended claims in Disease Category 6 (Asbestosis/Pleural Disease, Level II) and Disease Category 7 (Asbestosis/Pleural Disease Level I).

To date, the Keene Trust's filings remain low. The Trust's initial projections indicated the existence of over 120,000 malignant and severe asbestosis claims, and a fraction of these claims have been filed. To ensure that a Trust beneficiary receives his or her compensation, please ensure the claim filing is received timely. To expedite claim processing, claimants are encouraged to file on-line by following the instructions at the Claims Processing Facility Website (www.cpf-inc.com). It is possible that claims data submitted to the Eagle Picher Personal Injuries Settlement Trust may be used to expedite the preparation of claims for the Keene Creditors Trust for individuals who choose to file on-line.
