

ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT:


NOW. THEREFORE. the references to "three-year (3-year)" in Section 1.1 of the TDP are hereby deleted.


NOW THEREFORE, Section 5.1(a)(2) of the TDP is hereby amended by striking the second paragraph thereof and substituting the following paragraph:


If a Trust Claim meets any of the tolling provisions described in the preceding sentence and the claim was not barred by the statute of limitations at the time of the tolling event, it shall be treated as timely filed if it is actually filed with the Trust by November 30, 2021. In addition, any claims that were first diagnosed after the Petition Date but no later than twelve (12) months following the Effective Date of the Plan, irrespective of the application of any relevant federal, state, or foreign statute of limitations or repose, may be filed with the Trust within three (3) years after the date of diagnosis or by November 30, 2021, whichever occurs later. However, the processing of any Trust Claim may be deferred at the election of the claimant pursuant to Section 6.3 below.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Trustees, with the consent of the TAC and the FCR as provided in the Trust Agreement, have executed this Amendment to the TDP effective as of the date first above written. This Amendment to the TDP may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.


