Re: Closure of the UNR Asbestos-Disease Claims Trust [the "Trust"] – 4th Notice

Dear Claimants Counsel:

As you know, the current bar date for filing claims is December 31, 2018 and the Trust will close in 2019; this is the final notice. Any claim received after December 31, 2018 must be post-marked December 31, 2018 or earlier. Any claims submitted by Email must be received by the Trust by December 31, 2018.

We are sending this reminder so that you can prepare and file whatever claims you may have yet to file before the bar date, timely and accurately. **All requirements for filing an acceptable claim can be found on the website at www.cpf-inc.com.** There have been no changes to these requirements so you should be fully apprised so as not to file claims that do not meet the requirements.

Please avoid filing incomplete or inaccurate claim forms, as disallowed claims only waste time as well as forfeiture of the filing fee once a claim has been reviewed, whether the claim is perfected or not. If you have any doubts about filing requirements, please do not hesitate to contact the Trust *before* filing the claim.

It remains the Trust's objective to distribute remaining funds as fairly as possible to known beneficiaries of the Trust. Therefore, complying with deadlines is critical. Please specifically consider the following:

1. As you know, the Trust applies state statutes of limitation based on the filing status of a given claim. As a further reminder, ***filing a claim in the tort system does NOT toll the Statute as to the Trust or constitute filing with the Trust.*** Timely filing is based on when filed with the Trust accompanied by the required non-refundable filing fee of \$150.00. A claim will NOT be considered filed, nor will it be reviewed, until the filing fee is received; the measure of timing with regard to the applicable statute compliance is based on when the filing fee is received.
2. Currently, as advised in every offer letter, a claim will be considered abandoned and closed without payment if within the 180-day allowance for accepting Trust offers, no response has been received; if you currently have any ***unexpired*** offers, we urge you to

review them **now**, to avoid this action. If it appears that additional time is needed to respond, we must be advised **before** the deadline but depending on the nature of the request, we may not be able to grant it. Any additional time granted will of course depend on time available before closure.

3. Claims disallowed are considered withdrawn and closed without payment if no response has been received within the time allowed, as outlined in the disallowance notice. If additional time is necessary for you to provide the required information, you must advise the Trust **before** the deadline but depending on the nature of the request, we may not be able to allow it. If you currently have any unexpired disallowance notices, we urge you to review them now.

Please be sure that a copy of this notice is provided to all those in your office involved in the processing and handling of claims filed with the Trust.
